In the 1830 a high wall was built to protect the Quay from smuggling

In the 1844 in Exeter the railway arrived, so the Quay became less important.

In the 1950's the development of the economy began, so the Quay was regenerated.

Today Exeter is a very nice city, most important for the University and tourism.

The Bridges

The first Exe bridge had 13 arches and was built on a weir by Walter Gervaise in 1250
The second Exe bridge the Arches was completed in 1778

Another way to cross the river is the “Ferry Boat”.



The Ferry Boat
